Take a Walk on the Wild Side

Day 1

- Take a whale watching tour out of Morro Bay or Avila Beach
- Visit the Elephant Seals (last count, 2,600) in San Simeon

Day 2

- Take a docent-led birding trail walk with the Museum of Natural History in Morro Bay
- Go kayaking in Avila Beach or Morro Bay to view the birds, sea lions and otters up close.
- Take a guided hike along 55 miles of trails, ranging from inland volcanic peaks to pristine ocean bluffs.

Day 3

- Visit Pismo Beach Monarch Butterfly Grove, where 400,000 butterflies migrate annually. Docents are on hand to enhance and enlighten the experience.
